Major General Errol R. Schwartz is the Commanding General, Joint Force Headquarters, District of Columbia National Guard. He is responsible for operational readiness and command and control of the District of Columbia Army and Air National Guard units with an authorized strength of 2,500 Soldiers and Airmen.
